01 Customers & contracts

Who the Saudi customers are, how contracts will be delivered and whether a local entity is commercially required.

02 Activity & regulation

What the operation will do and which sector, investment, municipal or professional requirements may apply.

03 Investor & structure

The proposed investor, parent company, ownership position and governance required for the intended route.

04 Presence & people

The location, premises, management, workforce and practical responsibilities needed to operate after establishment.

ROUTES TO EXAMINE

Choose the structure around the committed Saudi presence.

01

LLC

A Saudi limited liability company

A locally incorporated company may suit an operation that needs a committed Saudi presence, local contracting and continuing activity. Ownership, capital, governance and sector conditions are checked first.

02

BR

A branch of a foreign company

An established foreign parent may examine a Saudi branch when the parent, activity and operating model support the route. Parent-company responsibilities and local approvals are reviewed before proceeding.

03

SEZ

A specialised or zone-based route

A specialised or economic-zone route may be relevant when the activity, location and eligibility conditions align. The operating substance and applicable authority requirements remain decisive.



FROM MARKET DECISION TO OPERATION

Five connected Saudi stages.

The investment path, company establishment, operating requirements and continuing responsibilities are coordinated as one sequence.

01

PLAN**Define the Saudi operation.**

Clarify the activity, customers, investor, proposed presence, team and commercial objective.

02

REGISTER**Confirm the investment path.**

Check the relevant investor registration route, evidence and connected sector requirements.

03

ESTABLISH**Coordinate company formation.**

Prepare the agreed company file and follow the establishment steps through suitable Saudi providers.

04

ACTIVATE**Prepare the company to operate.**

Connect premises, workforce, platforms, banking preparation and other operating foundations.

05

CONTINUE**Maintain the Saudi company.**

Coordinate recurring corporate obligations, providers and deadlines through one working calendar.

SAUDI ESTABLISHMENT SUPPORT

Coordinate the company and its operating foundations.

01

Market-entry assessment

Compare the activity, customers, presence and proposed route before the company work begins.

03

Sector requirements

Identify connected professional, municipal, activity or operating requirements and responsible providers.

05

Banking & finance readiness

Prepare the information flow and connect appropriately appointed banking, accounting and finance providers.

02

Registration & formation

Coordinate the investment path and company establishment through appointed Saudi providers.

04

Workforce & platforms

Coordinate employer, employee and relevant government-platform requirements with local specialists.

06

PRO & corporate compliance

Organise recurring obligations, provider responsibilities and deadlines through one corporate calendar.
